

Query for NFI data

Clicking on the menu item "Data" you can achieve NFI statistics between 2010-14 in the following groups

- [General data](#): the most important statistics at national level
- [Compile table](#): statistics according to the chosen themes and "Row/Column" parameters at level of different territorial unit
- [Maps](#): mapped statistics according to the chosen themes and "Row/Column" parameters at level of different territorial unit
- Other data
 - [Comparison of databases](#): Comparison of NFI data with the data of the stand wise forest inventory (SFI)
 - [Function for Diameter at breast height and diameter at the base](#): Function and inverse function for the diameter at breast height and diameter at the base for different tree species and arguments of the functions.
 - [Height curves](#): Height curves for the common tree species generated by NFI data at national level.

The optional “Row/Column” parameters appear according to the first three characteristics and the other already chosen “Row/Column” parameter. On the lists only the active parameters can be selected. Although the “Row/Column” parameters are interchangeable, the result of the query (in favor of the optimal appearance) is the same statistical tables. For new search click on the “Reset” button.
